Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

ARRIVAL: Buses will be using Cynthia Street entrance and dropping off our students at the front entrance of the building. Parents who are driving to school and dropping off students please use Lancaster Drive entrance and form a line that will extend down Lancaster Drive. At 8:45AM there will be two staff members who will be posted at the door at the north end of the building (this door is to the left of the double gym doors). The staff members will dismiss the students from the cars in a quick and organized manner. Once your child is out of the care we will have cones blocking off 6 or so parking spaces for you to pull up and through to exit back down Lancaster Drive. Thank you in advance for your patience as we develop a habit of safe arrival.

DISMISSAL: If you are picking up your child at the end of the day please be sure the orange name placard is displayed in the windshield so that staff members can easily read your child's name. Please use Lancaster Drive entrance and form a line that will extend down Lancaster Drive much like the morning drop off. At 3:25PM there will be two staff members who will be posted at the door at the north end of the building. <u>The staff members will</u> dismiss the students from the gym to your car. (Parents will no longer enter the building to pick up their child. For our 3rd grade parents this student pick up is much like the Garfield pick up procedure). Once your child is safely in the car please exit using Cynthia Street. Thank you in advance for your patience as we work toward a safe, quick and organized dismissal for car riders. Again, our children's safety is our primary concern. Walkers will be dismissed after the majority of the traffic has dispersed.

Your personalized Orange Car Placard for Pick Up is with this packet. Please see your child's teacher if you do not have an Orange Card with your child's name on it!
